



This celebration highlights the balance between spirituality, culture, and artistic expression, making it an enriching experience for everyone involved.














Shape Recognition



Teaching colors and shapes to children is foundational for their cognitive development and learning.

- 1. *Identification Skills*: Children will be able to recognize and name different color and shapes, which is essential for language development and categorization skills.
- 2. *Sorting and Classification*: They will learn to sort objects based on color and shape, enhancing their ability to classify and organize information.
- 3. *Visual Discrimination*: Developing the ability to distinguish between different shapes and colors improves visual discrimination skills, which are crucial for reading and mathematical concepts late on.
- 4. *Memory and Recall*: Recognizing and remembering different colors and shape helps strengthen memory and recal abilities.





Tens and ones Activity










The "Tens and Ones" activity with ice cream sticks helps children understand place value. Students learn to group sticks into bundles of ten (tens) and leave single sticks (ones). This shows how numbers are made up of tens and ones. For example, 23 is 2 bundles of ten and 3 single sticks. Through this activity, children practice counting, adding, and subtracting by moving sticks. It makes numbers easier to understand and helps connect symbols (like 10 or 20) to actual quantities. This fun, hands-on activity also improves problem-solving and fine motor skills.


- Be patient and understanding: Be patient and understanding when dealing with your child's mistakes or misbehavior.






