PLANETS OF THE SOLAR SYSTEM

INNER PLANETS

The inner planets – Mercury, Venus, Earth, and Mars – are closest to the Sun and have rocky surfaces. These terrestrial planets are smaller in size and include Earth, the only planet known to support life.

GAS GIANTS

Jupiter and Saturn are gas giants with thick atmospheres composed mainly of hydrogen and helium. These huge planets are much larger than the inner planets and Jupiter is notable for its Great Red Spot.

DWARF PLANETS

Pluto, Eris and other dwarf planets orbit the Sun but do not meet all the criteria to be classified as full-fledged planets. They are smaller than the major planets and have varied features.

- Offer rewards and incentives for good hygiene practices


